

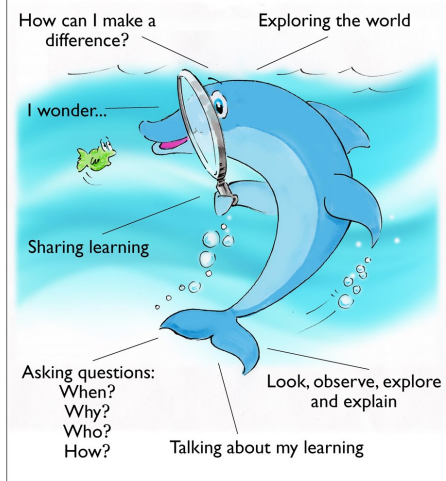

School Absence-Important Procedures

Please note, your child's absence **must be reported every day**. Unless it is vomiting/diarrhoea and we have already been informed, or an illness where we know they will be off for a number of days. Please call the school office at anytime on 0208 979-2770 and press option 1 and leave a message. We appreciate your cooperation which will save the office staff having to run around the school to see whether your child is in or not!



Medical evidence may be required for absences longer than 5 days and when attendance falls below 90%.

Please also provide written proof of any appointments and advise whether your child will be requiring a school meal.

May we also remind you that if your child has vomiting and/or diarrhoea, you must wait 48 hours from the last episode before bringing your child back to school.

New Uniform from September

Just to remind you that our new, [bottle green coloured federation school uniform](#) will be in place from September and available from School Days in Whitton (we will share the updated uniform guidance with you soon).

We are looking forward to seeing all children proudly wearing this new federation uniform but appreciate that this will take a period of time to settle in, with children still wearing their current CIS or HHJS uniform in September.

Initially we are expecting all reception and Y3 children to start the new year in the new school uniform.

We do have current second hand uniform at both schools and this will be available through the summer term to support families. If any family needs support with this change to a new uniform, we would ask them to contact us through the school office.

Cool Milk—Reception Children-IMPORTANT INFO

Please remember that all children under the age of 5 will receive free Government funded milk. **When your child turns 5, or if they are already over the age of 5, you have the option to pay for their milk directly through Cool Milk.**

If you would like your child to receive milk, then please visit www.coolmilk.com and select “register your child for milk here” then follow the on-screen instructions to register and pay.

Please be aware the cut off date is Tuesday for milk orders to commence the following week. All parent/ carers must contact cool milk if they have any problems.

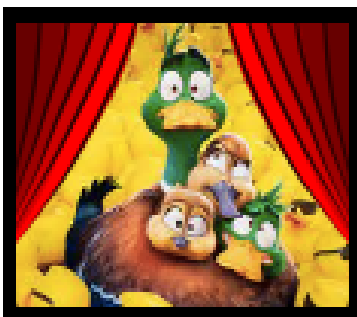

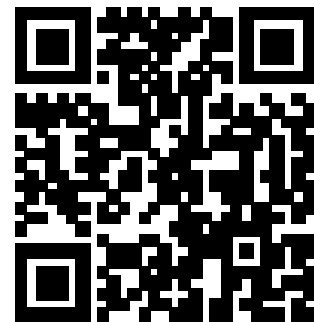
