| <p>100% of respondents suggested that their children were happy, feel safe and felt confident that we ensure pupils are well behaved at this school.</p> | <p>Continue to induct and train our new staff with our expectations for their manner around children and their approach to support children with their concerns. We will also ensure all our staff deal with behaviour in a consistent manner, supported by our Behaviour Policy.</p> |
| <p>A small proportion of respondents felt that the school wasn't clear about what children will learn during the year.</p> | <p>Ensure that the Carlisle Curriculum Booklets are emailed to all families as early as possible in the new half term to inform you of what your child(ren) will be learning in each half term. Draw your attention to our Curriculum Maps (at the top of each subject specific page) which give you an overview of the learning that will be covered throughout the year.</p> |
| <p>Some feedback suggested that the school could do better at sharing how children are doing, with particular focus on academic successes and next steps.</p> | <p>Carefully consider ways we can maximise the information we can share with you during our parent consultations in the autumn and spring so you can feel better informed of your child's current successes and areas for development.</p> |
| <p>Some families would like to be more involved in the events and workshops that occur at Carlisle Infant School but the timings of these and short notice mean these are difficult to attend.</p> | <p>We will aim to communicate upcoming events in a timely manner and avoid changing the date whenever possible. We do try and limit the number of evening/out of school time events we host in consideration of staff wellbeing, however will always try and share slides from the meetings for families who are unable to attend.</p> |
| <p>Reading books are not consistently changed in all classes and the ebooks hadn't been updated for the current reading level.</p> | <p>We are disappointed that this was the experience of some families last year and was not our intention. We have timetabled a book changing day each week where we will ensure your child takes home a Little Wandle Letters and Sounds decodable reading book and will ensure access to ebooks are updated regularly.</p> |
| <p>Communication isn't always as informative as we'd hope and can be difficult to interpret.</p> | <p>We aim to share necessary information with our community to ensure they are informed as much as possible. We have reviewed our practices this year by opting to send out the bulk of our communications on a Friday to give our families a few days over the weekend to read and digest the information. We will consider the feedback we have received in regards to the difficulties faced in interpreting the messages when we communicate, moving forward.</p> |
