Children will take part in a variety of activities throughout the morning and we encourage families to move along in the 'spectator zone' to see their children participating in the different events.

There will be a CSA Refreshment Stall to keep you hydrated during the morning.

Due to the related risks and health and safety concerns we have decided not to have any races involving adults this year.
