## Y4 Egyptian Day

As you know, we have had a very enjoyable start to our creative curriculum last term studying all aspects of Ancient Egypt. As a way of celebrating the end of this project we have organised an **Egyptian Day on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April** where the children will experience a range of activities based around Ancient Egyptian life. On this day, we would like the children to dress up as an Ancient Egyptian. They will also need to bring in a packed lunch please.

As part of this topic, we will be making flatbread. We have learnt lots about Ancient Egypt and the children will be using this to design their own recipe for flatbread. We will be celebrating with a banquet on Egyptian Day where the children get to eat their bread with other traditional food. The school will provide basic ingredients (flour, butter, salt) as well as other items for the children to enjoy with their bread! The two extra ingredients that they chose last term, to add into the recipe, **need to be provided by the children (fruit/vegetable and herb/spice).** **The children will need to bring these ingredients in on Thursday as they will be baking their bread on Thursday and Friday morning,** ready for the feast on Egyptian Day.

We have also been offered a fantastic theatre workshop from the Aesop Theatre company: 'Search for the Lost Tomb'. With this workshop and the cooking of the flatbread, we are asking for a donation of £4.00.
