HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

The staff, Governors and children at Hampton Hill Junior School, believe that the Home-School partnership is very important. We welcome and value parental support and involvement. We aim to ensure effective channels of communication between home and school.

We (the school) shall:

- Get to know each child as an individual.
- Ensure that while in our care, the safety and welfare of each child is paramount.
- Aim to create a positive, caring atmosphere in which each child feels secure and valued, and is able to make the best progress possible.
- Work in partnership with parents / carers to encourage positive attitudes and behaviour, a respect for others and for the environment.
- Maintain regular and effective communications with parents / carers on all aspects of school life.

I (the child) shall:

- Be on time for school every day with the appropriate equipment and clothing.
- Be polite, thoughtful and helpful to others.
- Respect and care for all property and the school environment.
- Follow the school's safety rules.
- Do all my classwork and homework as well as I can.
- Try to have my home/school diary in school and up to date every day.

I (parent/carer) shall:

- Ensure that my child arrives at school by 8.55am with the necessary equipment and clothing and to notify the school of the reason for any absence.
- Ensure my child has good attendance and we will not take holidays during term time.
- Make the school aware of anything that might affect my child's behaviour or work.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour.
- Try and check and be involved with my child's homework.
- Get to know and support what my child does in school through school/home communications.
- Try to attend Parents Evenings, information sessions and extra-curricular activities whenever possible.
- Oversee the controlled and careful use of social network sites out of school hours
- Understand that mobile phones, cameras, fitbits, MP3 players should not be seen or used in school hours.
