The 3 Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig – Eugene Trivizas & Helen Oxenbury (a twist on the original story)

Revolting Rhymes – Roald Dahl (hilarious versions of well-known fairy tales)

The Giving Tree – Shel Silverstein (a great book for discussing giving and sharing)

Planet Omar, Accidental Trouble Magnet – Zanib Mian (a funny and interesting book about a boy who has lots of new things happening to him)

Anisha Accidental Detective – Serena Patel (an action packed adventure with clues to uncover and a mystery to be solved)

Ottoline and the Yellow Cat – Chris Riddell (a fantasy adventure that is beautifully illustrated)

The Magician’s Nephew – C.S.Lewis (the first of the Narnia Chronicles. For the more able reader)

The Hodgeheg – Dick King-Smith (a good ‘chapter book’)

The Boy Who Grew Dragons – Andy Shepherd (an adventure story about a boy whose dragon fruit from the tree in his garden begins hatching...)
